The DAISY Award is an international recognition program started in memory of J. Patrick Barnes. Pat's family experienced first-hand the difference his nurses made in his care through clinical excellence and outstanding compassionate care. The family created The DAISY Award to express gratitude to nurses and to enable other patients, families, and staff to thank and honor their special nurses.

Compassionate care is the heart of nursing. The International Home Care Nurses Organization ([IHCNO](#)), as a Supporting Organization of the [Daisy Foundation](#), shares the goal of recognizing home care nurses or midwives from throughout the world for providing compassionate care.

The criteria for the IHCNO Daisy Award are:

- A. Models empathy and demonstrates a caring presence in all situation.
- B. Demonstrates excellent clinical skills in the delivery of compassionate patient care.
- C. Demonstrates professionalism in the work environment.
- D. Establishes a special connection with the patients and families.

Nominations will be reviewed and selected by a committee of experienced home care nurses. Patients, families, co-workers, or the nominee, can complete the form for this award.

Nominations are due by May 12, 2021.
